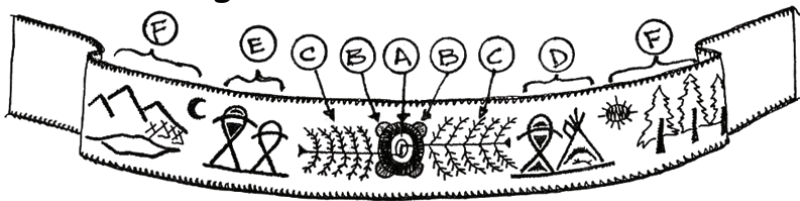


The Legend of the Guide Headband



- A) The central headband theme is the eye of the *Great Spirit*.
- B) The four half circles surrounding the eye represent the four winds of heaven.
- C) The design of feathered arrows represents the services of fathers and sons. Where they join in the eye's center indicates their working together.
- D) Symbols of mother and home (indicated by fire in tepee).
- E) Symbols of father and son (indicated by the line that joins them).
- F) Symbols on the right and left show forest, field, stream, community (tepees), day (sun) and night (moon).

The symbols story emphasizes the meaning of the aims featuring fathers and sons involvement in family, community and preservation "in forest, field and stream".
